SPOTLIGHT ON: Patient Elicitation Workshop



"Learn How to Swing: Hands-on workshop on preference elicitation in the age of personalised medicine"

On **Monday afternoon** we will be holding a **patient preference elicitation workshop**, run by the Benefit-Risk SIG.

Factoring in a patients preference when you are making Benefit-Risk assessments, between multiple different drugs or doses of the same drug, can lead to a number

of questions, such as:

- What is more important - more symptom reduction or less adverse events?
- Which adverse events are more important to patients?
- Which efficacy parameters are most important to patients?

Everyone in your team will have an opinion on this! But these will all reflect personal preferences. There is also a lack of transparency to these discussions in terms of how you come up with your trade off.

During this 90 minute workshop, you will learn about the advantages and problems with patient preference elicitation from the design of the study to the analysis of the data.
