The PSI Conference

Regarded as the principal annual event for statisticians in the pharmaceutical industry, the 2019 PSI Conference will be taking place at the QEII in London. This will be the 42nd consecutive annual PSI event. The conference is held over a three day period and made up of plenary sessions, parallel sessions, a poster display and the annual general meeting. Breaks (coffee and lunch) taken throughout the day are located within the exhibition area permitting maximum exhibitor exposure to all delegates.

Sponsorship

Exhibition

The exhibition will be held within the conference area. Space will be allocated on a first-come first-served basis. Set-up will be possible during Sunday 2 June. All stands must be dismantled directly on Wednesday 5 June and the area totally cleared by 15:00. The price includes two exhibitor passes for the three conference days which gain access to the exhibition area only, and includes two tickets to the Gala Dinner. If you would like to upgrade the pass to a full delegate place it is only an additional £370 per person. Dinner, bed and breakfast costs are additional. Additional exhibitor passes can be purchased for £540 at the Early Bird fee, or £600 at the full fee rate. Exhibiting companies must provide their own public liability insurance.
